Past Forward Native American Art from Gilcrease Museum

Past Forward: Native American Art from Gilcrease Museum surveys more than 3,000 years of Indigenous art, encompassing fine art along with archaeological and archival materials. The exhibition presents 76 works whose visual motifs and shared systems of knowledge connect disparate ancestries, time, and space. It explores the transhistorical themes of ceremony, sovereignty, visual abstraction, and identity, telling the story of the U.S. through art that emphasizes Native cultures and the history of the American West.


